**Canadian Museum for Human Rights | Musée canadien pour les droits de la personne**

Participants will engage in a guided museum tour as well as have time to explore the museum on a self-guided tour as part of the museum experience.

The guided museum tour will include focused content on women and girls, with special attention paid to Canadian and African stories related to women’s rights and children’s rights. At the time of our visit, there will be a special exhibit focusing on women's cooperatives – *Empowering Women* – showcasing Rwanda, Swaziland, South Africa, and Kenya (a few of the African countries where the SLF partners), and Morocco. Additionally, participants will engage in the fun Weaving Change program where we will learn about how grandmothers in South Africa yarn-bombed trees with crocheted squares to raise awareness on World AIDS Day 2012. Participants will learn how to finger-weave one of the patterns on the Museum’s Yarn-bombed tree exhibit in the Inspiring Change Gallery on Level 7.
