8. Session Information: Here is a brief description of the Saturday sessions.
Go to question 9 to choose your session preferences.

Session 1: How do African community-based organizations measure impact and resilience? Resilience is the true measure of impact at the grassroots in Africa. This session will explore community-based responses to the AIDS pandemic in Africa and the role of the Stephen Lewis Foundation and, more importantly, our African partners, in challenging and redefining measures of "success" at community level, nationally and internationally. ACTION: As African communities are measuring their success, how will we measure ours?

Session 2: How can we best use the SLF's online resources to expand our reach? Join SLF staff as they explore with us the G2G website, Facebook and SLF's online fundraising pages. You might also get a peek at a new project they are working on. ACTION: In what new ways can we use these tools to assist our awareness and fundraising?

Session 3: What fund raising ideas have you NOT thought of yet? Debbie Hagman, Community Development Officer with Alberta Culture will share some fun and different ideas for raising funds. ACTION: How will you adjust your fundraising going forward?

Session 4: What are some of the latest grandmothers' initiatives in Zambia? Ida Nameya Mukaka, Consultant to the Grandmother's Campaign, will share stories from her most recent visit with community-based organizations in Zambia. Ida spoke with grandmothers, grandchildren, and local organization staff members about grandmothers' initiatives, as well as the successes and challenges currently facing grandmothers and their communities. ACTION: How will I use Ida's stories when talking about the Grandmother Campaign?

Session 5: What messages do the African Grandmothers want us to hear? At this session we will hear more from our special guests: the African grandmothers from Uganda and Zimbabwe and project staff. This is a wonderful opportunity for deeper

conversation and asking questions. ACTION: How can we amplify the African Grandmothers' voices in our community?
