Key Messages to Communicate to Others

- African grandmothers are central to the life of their communities. They become parents again, caring for their orphaned grandchildren in the midst of the HIV and AIDS pandemic.
- Grandmothers deliver home-based care in their communities.
 They put their grandchildren through school, teach HIV prevention, create local savings and loans groups, and participate in innovative income-generating programmes.
- In the face of gender and age discrimination, African grandmothers are leaders and advocates for their human rights locally and nationally.
- The Stephen Lewis Foundation's Grandmothers to Grandmothers Campaign was launched in 2006 in response to the emerging crisis faced by African grandmothers.
- 2016 marks the 10 Year Anniversary of the Grandmothers to Grandmothers Campaign. Ten years of raising awareness in communities in Canada and abroad. Ten years of fundraising, now more than \$24 million. Ten years of learning and nurturing solidarity.
- African grandmothers are changing the course of the pandemic in their communities and beyond. And the Grandmothers to Grandmothers Campaign is with them every step of the way.
- The Stephen Lewis Foundation works with African community-based organizations that are turning the tide of HIV/AIDS in Africa. Since 2003, they have funded over 1,400 initiatives, partnering with more than 300 grassroots organizations in the 15 African countries hardest by the pandemic.
